## Rationale for Request (~100 words)

The primary rationale for the proposed program fee is to enable SGPP to hire requisite faculty. Similar to our longstanding Masters of Public Administration (MPA) program, the MPP requires adjunct faculty to teach many of the non-core MPP classes (we anticipate hiring approximately four to five adjuncts per year at \$5000-\$7,500 per class). In addition to salaries, SGPP provides financial support to the Masters of Public Policy and Administration Student Association (MPPASA) and hosts networking events with alumni as well as career development seminars.

### Compliance with Board Guidelines (~250 words)

SGPP will continue to use program fees in accordance with the Student Governance Board's guidelines. This includes the following uses:

- Reserve 14% of all fees for financial aid and 10% for administrative charges
- Adjunct faculty salaries (~4 per year)
- Networking programs
- Conference support

### Student Consultation (~100 words)

The MPP Program Director (Craig Smith) and MPP Advisor (Laura Bakkensen) met with MPP students to discuss the proposed fee on 10/20/15. Professors Smith and Bakkensen provided rationales for the fee and gave students a chance to ask questions and offer comments. Students understood the need to hire adjunct faculty and support funds being used for student services and career development and approved the proposed plan.
